APPLICATION FOR WATER SERVICE

The undersigned hereby requests residential water service from the Neah-kah-nie Water District ("District") to service the property indicated below. In consideration of such service, applicant agrees to pay the following:

System Development Charge:	\$6,429
Service Connection Fee:	<u>\$1,500 ¾ inch / \$2,000 1 inch</u>
Total Fees to be paid:	\$7,929 / \$8,429

The Service Connection Fee includes District-supplied materials for the connection (service saddle, service line, valves, fittings, meter, meter box and any other materials required), supervision and inspection of the installation and permit from Tillamook County. The following applies to any service connection:

- Any costs incurred by the District in connection with the service connection that exceed the Service Connection Fee will be charged to the applicant and will be paid prior to any water being provided to the applicant.
- District at its option may install the service line from the District's main water line to applicant's water meter and all costs incurred by the District in connection with such installation shall be paid by the applicant.
- If the District requires that the applicant install the service line from District's main water line to the meter, any contractor used by the applicant must be approved by the District prior to any work commencing.
- When applicant installs the service line, the cost of equipment and labor for excavation of the service line trench, saw cutting the street paving, water main tap, installation of district-supplied materials, backfill, pavement replacement and any other installation costs required will be paid directly by applicant to their contractor.
- All such installations shall comply with District specifications and requirements and shall be inspected and accepted by a District representative prior to any coverage of the service line being applied including without limitation any backfill or pavement replacement. If such inspection and approval by the District does not occur prior to application of backfill or pavement replacement, District may require all such coverage be removed so inspection can occur. No water will be supplied until the connection has been inspected and approved by the District and proper backfill has been applied and inspected by the District.

- Future maintenance of the service by the District between District's main water line and applicant's water meter will begin upon acceptance of the installation by the District and proper coverage by the service line by applicant's contractor.
- Applicant is responsible for installation and maintenance of the service line from the meter to the residence, and for maintaining the meter box's visibility and accessibility at all times.

In the event applicant requests or is required to have a one-inch service connection, the Service Connection Fee will be \$2000.00 and all other provisions of the preceding paragraph shall apply.

Applicant further agrees to abide by all Rules and Regulations of the District and further understands that the water service supplied by the District shall be employed for domestic use only.

District agrees only to supply water in an amount and at a pressure required by state law and assumes no responsibility for any lines on private property, nor for any damages resulting from installation or maintenance of such lines.

During summer months, the District's water supply may be limited. Therefore, the District urges that only water saver fixtures be installed. The District also recommends that only plants with low water requirements and are drought tolerant be used in landscaping.

District regulations require the installation of a pressure reducing valve and hand shut-off valve near the entry point of the house.

In conformance with District policy on cross-connections the applicant may be required to install an approved backflow prevention device at their own cost and have annual inspections by a qualified technician with an operational certification submitted to the District.

The District has limited water storage capacity available for firefighting. If your planned dwelling unit will be 3600 square feet or larger, you must consult with the Nehalem Bay Fire and Rescue District regarding the need for installing a residential fire sprinkler protection system. Any such system will require a one inch meter and service connection.
